This execution could not be decided within sixty days as per the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court primarily because the recovery warrant was issued on dt. 02.05.2023 and transmitted for execution to the District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, the said authority failed to make the compliance.

Report no.193 dt. 21.07.2023 has been received from Tehsildar-Amritsar-2 that the recovery warrant was marked to Naib Tehsildar-Amritsar-2, but, no report has been received from the Naib Tehsildar.

Fresh reminder be issued to District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar for realisation of the due amount on the basis of recovery certificate on or before 12.09.2023. However, as the concerned revenue authority has not been able to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court regarding completion of the proceedings of execution within 60 days from the date of filing; therefore, notice is required to be issued to the concerned Naib Tehsildar through District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar for showing cause as to why the matter should not be referred to the Hon'ble High Court for initiating contempt proceedings because of the default of the concerned Tehsildar in deliberately not complying with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court as per the guidelines of the Hon'ble Apex Court and explanation by concerned Naib Tehsildar with the comments of District Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar be submitted on or before 12.09.2023. Copy of the reminder be also sent to the Tehsildar, RERA, Punjab. Process be also sent through email.
